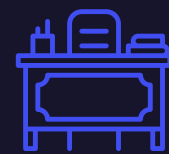

**Must match CARES Financial Aid Allotment at least 1:1**

*Ex. If awarded \$300,00 for financial aid for CARES, must dedicate at least \$300,00 to financial aid in HEERF II*

**Must prioritize exceptional need cases** and can be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care.



**Remaining = Institutional Portion**

- ✓ Defray expenses related to coronavirus including lost revenue, reimbursement for expenses already incurred, technology costs associated with a transition to distance education, faculty and staff trainings, and payroll)
- ✓ Carry out student support activities authorized by the HEA that address needs related to coronavirus
- ✓ Additional Student Financial Aid.
